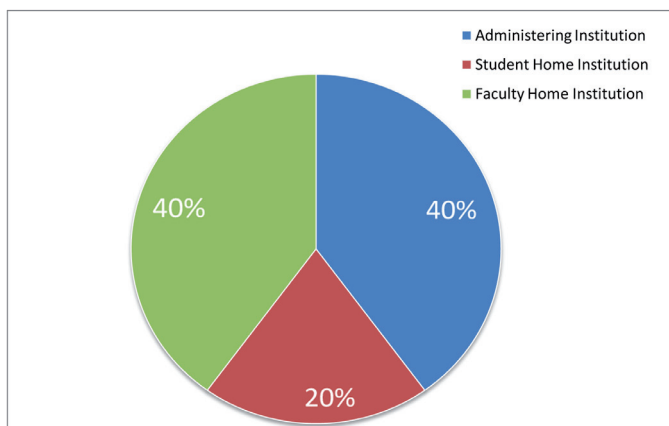

eCore Financial Model



Self-Sustaining Model

eCore through UWG has a financial model consisting of three cost centers: the administrative institution, the student home institution, and the faculty home institution:

- 40% to the Administering Institution
- 20% to the Student Home Institution (census date)
- 40% to the Faculty Home Institution

Each student institution also keeps 100% of tuition from students withdrawing before the withdrawal deadline.

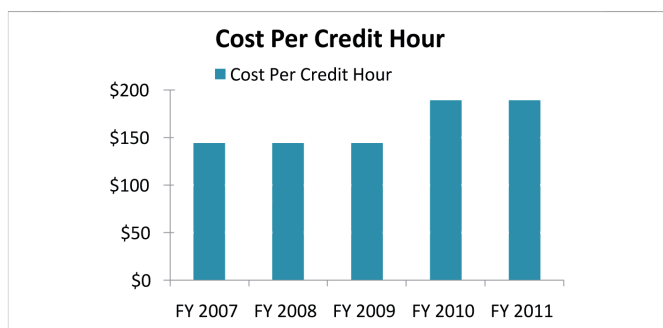
eCore is a completely self-sustaining program and requires no state appropriations.

Tuition

The cost of eCore is \$189 per credit hour. The tuition rates for the same period at our affiliates are as follows:

- Clayton State University- \$146.74
- Macon State College- \$92.54
- Southern Polytechnic State University - \$166.00
- University of West Georgia- \$154.00
- Valdosta State University- \$154.00

While the eCore tuition is slightly higher, traditional fees that are mandated when a student enrolls in face-to-face courses are not applied. If a student is enrolled only in eCore classes, he or she is exempt from other fees associated with face-to-face courses.
