

Course Preparation

Preparation studies between pre-requisite and subsequent courses is an important component in measuring overall success of the eCore program. There are two course sequences in eCore with a direct relationship between the pre-requisite course and the subsequent course: ENGL 1101 / ENGL 1102 and SPAN 2001 / SPAN 2002.

An eCore student can take one or both of the course sequences in eCore. Alternatively, a student could be taking one or both courses in a Campus setting. If only one course is taken in eCore, then the other course is taken in a Campus setting. For preparatory studies, the combinations of eCore – Campus and Campus – eCore are compared for ENGL 1101 / ENGL 1102 and SPAN 2001 / SPAN 2002 courses.

The following data is provided by UWG and SPSU. This summary represents data for all courses to have been completed in FY 2011 only.
