New Learning Management System

During the Fall of 2012, the eCore Department of Curriculum and Instruction conducted a series of face-to-face and virtual training sessions for the implementation of the GoVIEW learning environment powered by the Desire2Learn Learning Management System. The team traveled to locations in Georgia to provide orientation and hands-on guidance for eCore faculty members. Webinars and archived demonstrations and tutorials were made available to faculty members along with demo courses for exploration. In Spring 2013, the system went live with students, and faculty engaged in teaching and learning with new tools.

Data from course evaluations and instructor feedback from the annual meeting will be reviewed in order to assess where improvements are needed in navigation, teaching, learning, and administration using the new learning management system.

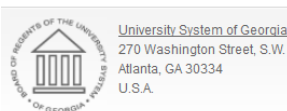

Course Start Items

In collaboration with the eCore Student Success Team, the eCore Department of Curriculum and Instruction has configured an eCore Start-Up Quiz for every course offered. The quiz serves as an attendance verification tool and has a series of questions that call on students' knowledge of the dates, tasks, policies, and procedures needed to properly function in their eCore course.
