

Overall Student Course Satisfaction

With over 2,600 completed course evaluations for FY 2013, students show an overall satisfaction of approximately 87% based on 4.33 out of 5.00 points on Likert scoring. The eCore Administration surveyed students using an online survey instrument and retrieved results from 19 of the Likert-style questions for analysis. The response options were based on a five-point Likert scale: Strongly Agree (5), Agree (4), Neutral (3), Disagree (2), and Strongly Disagree (1).

Below are the averaged Likert score calculations for the past four fiscal years. A trend analysis is provided at the far right of the table for each of the course subjects.
