

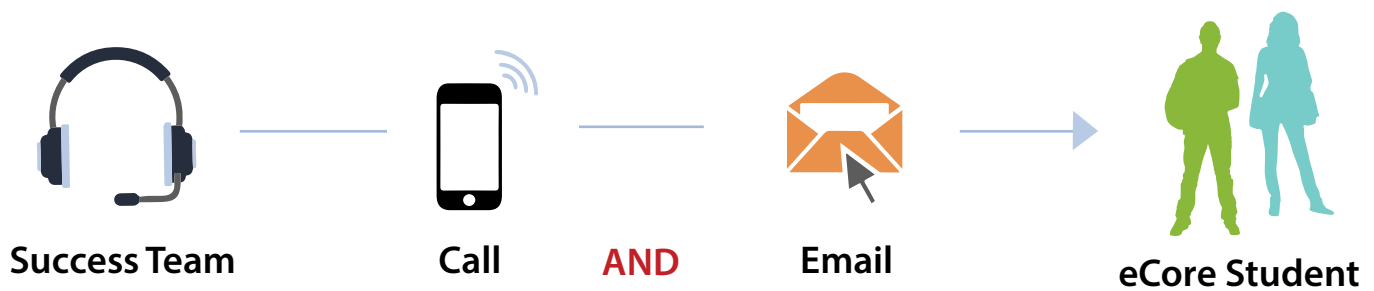
## Student Engagement and Success

eCore has a clearly defined process for supporting and assisting students toward full engagement and success in eCore coursework. This includes providing students with access to academic resources and online tutoring options. The eCore intervention process has become one of the hallmarks of the program. This model provides instructors with an opportunity to report students on a weekly basis and allows the eCore Student Success Team to reach out and contact students to provide resource solutions. This closes the loop back to the professor on the follow-up process. If a student does choose to withdraw from an eCore course, a withdrawal survey is requested to gather data on the student's eCore learning experience; and the Student Success Team contacts the student about the withdrawal to provide details and options for an informed decision.

Engagement includes tutoring resources, preemptive and startup activities, the eCore Connection tutorial class, and in-term outbound contacts for at-risk and withdrawal activities.
