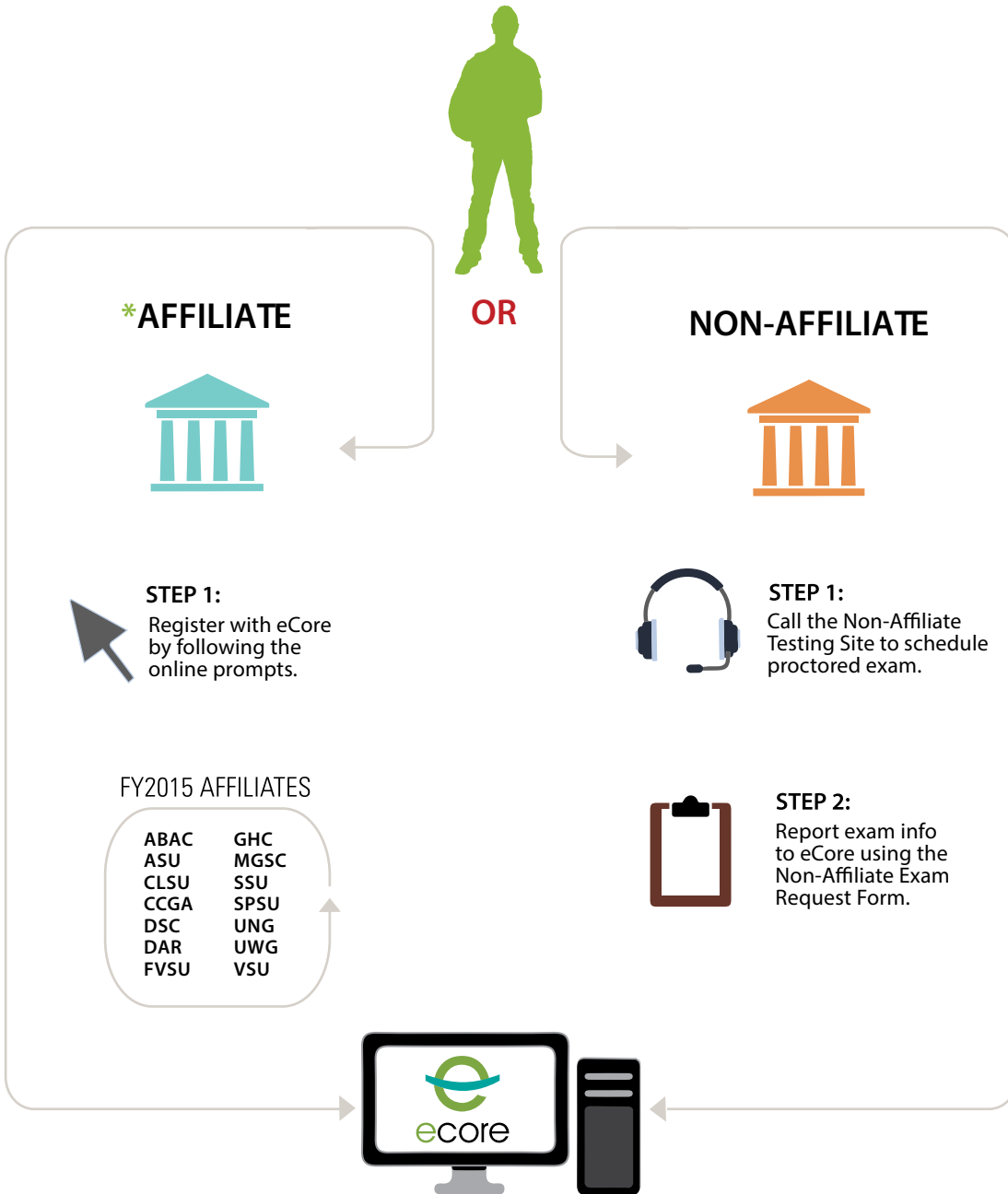


# Testing Information

## Where are Students Taking Proctored Exams?

eCore knows that assessment is a critical component in online course delivery. This is the reason that so much effort has been placed on providing convenient testing methods to all eCore students while maintaining the highest level of verification possible. This also allows eCore classes the greatest level of transferability for both students and institutions.



## Proctored Online Exams for eCore Courses

In an effort to heighten security and reduce costs, eCore has moved away from paper-based exams. Instead, eCore encourages instructors to use Desire2Learn, i.e., GoView for their exams. Since Summer 2009, eCore faculty generally use proctored online tests for midterms or finals to assess a student's progress in the course in a secure environment. Students in online courses must fulfill their responsibilities in scheduling and taking a proctored exam.

## Approved eCore Testing Sites and Proctors

A student may request to add a testing center to the List of Approved eCore Testing Sites & Proctors. According to eCore policies, only public testing centers (college, university, library or Army base education centers) with adequate access to GoView are able to proctor exams and may be added to the List of Approved Proctors. The eCore Testing Coordinator carefully screens each requested testing center.

Each proctor from an approved testing site must have the ability to use the following:

- A valid and working e-mail address
- Internet access for students taking online exams delivered via GoView

## Revenue Generated by Affiliate Testing Centers

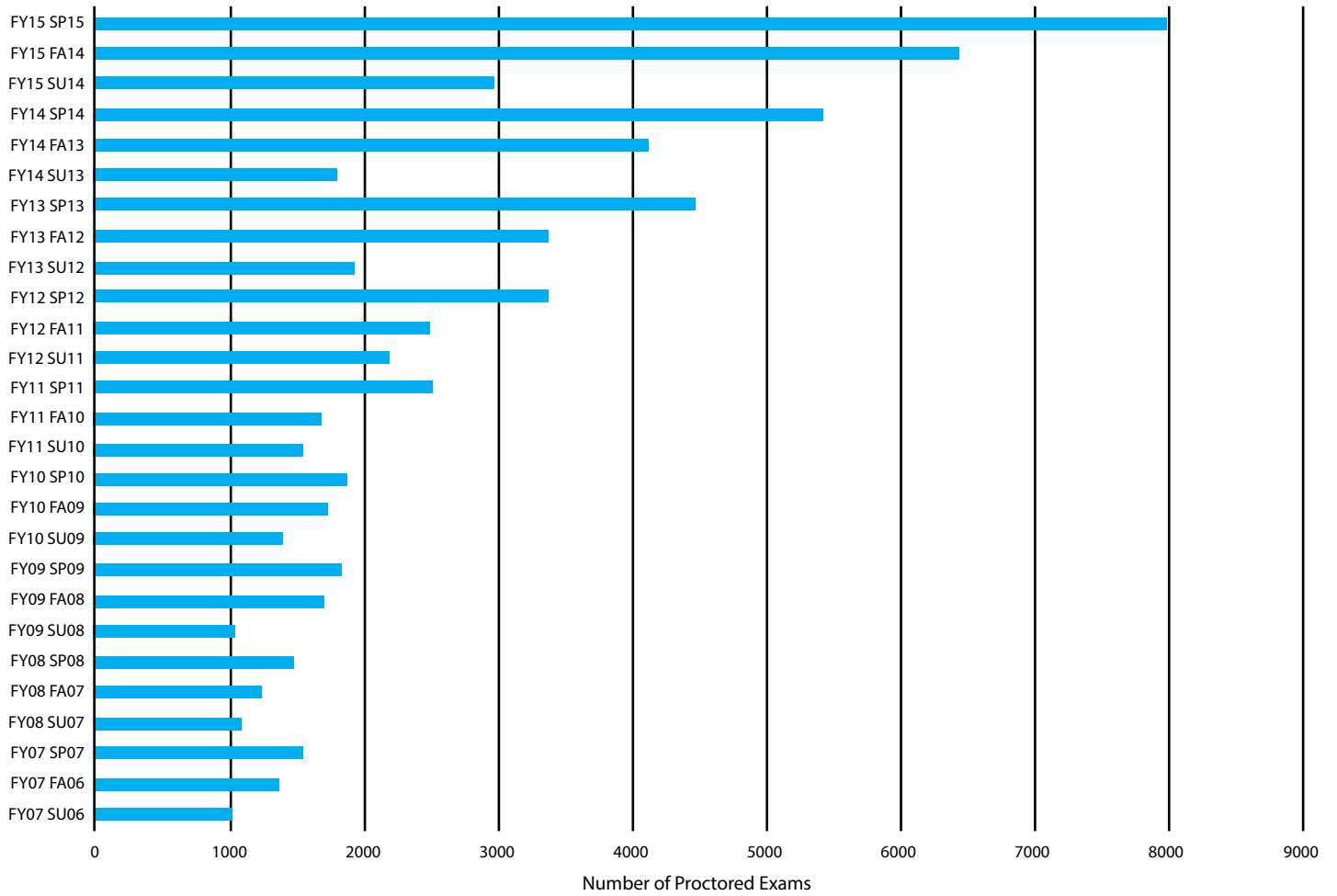

## MAJOR FINDINGS

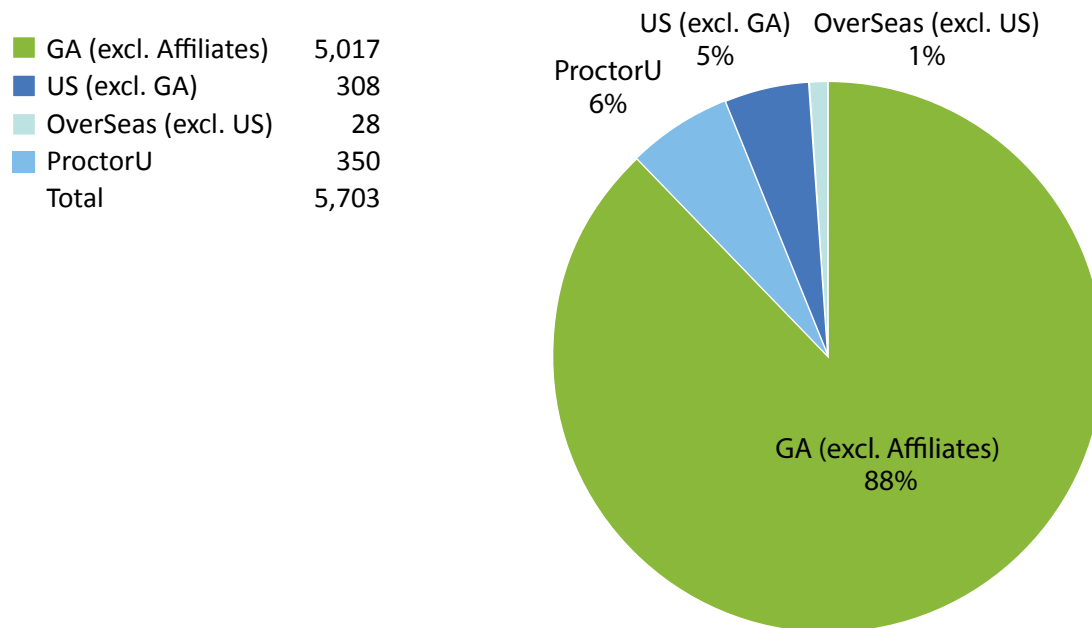
- Proctored exam fees average \$21 per exam among affiliates.
- 88.98% of eCore students take their exams at an affiliate institution.
- In FY 15, there were 17,376 eCore proctored exams administered.

## Test Scheduling Process

With RegisterBlast, students may register for the necessary exam in a quick and efficient manner. They simply click on the exam needed and then choose a testing date and time. The process is complete when the students receive an email confirming the details of their registrations. This eliminates the need for students to call a testing center in order to schedule an exam. RegisterBlast is accessible 24/7 and is currently the registration tool of choice for ten affiliate testing centers: ABAC, ASU, CCGA, CLSU, DAR, DSC, FVSU, GHC, MGSC, SPSU, SSU, UNG, UWG, and VSU.

## DID YOU KNOW?

- Exams were taken in 37 states plus Washington D.C.
- eCore students took exams in China, Cuba, Guatemala, Kuwait, Germany, Japan, Pakistan, and the United Arab Emirates.
- The average time the RegisterBlast process saved an affiliate testing center was five minutes per registration.
